

Engineering: Transfer to UVIC

Columbia College students seeking admission to Engineering at UVIC are advised to take the following core courses and complementary studies courses.

Minimum 24 transferable/relevant credits required for admission.

A minimum grade of C is required in all CSCI and MATH courses.

One **Complementary Studies (CS)** course (3 credits): UVIC Engineering has a list of courses which have been given CS status over the last 5 years. **Students are required to check in advance with a program advisor in the UVIC BEng office to ensure that the course they wish to take at CC or at UVIC qualifies as a CS course.** Some of the courses CC offers that transfer to UVIC as CS approved courses are

- ARTH 220
- BUSN 272
- ECON 103 (Civil Engineering only), 105, 207, 240
- ENGL 210, 215, 230, 240
- CMNS 199, 221
- PHIL 101 + PHIL 102 (need both), 113, 260
- PSCI 101, 202, 210, 240
- SOCI 110, 120

Additional courses *may* be granted CS status, but **approval must be obtained in advance** for such CS courses.
